Investment objective

The Fund aims to track the performance of the FTSE All-World Index (the "Index") before the deduction of charges and tax.



Investment strategy

The Fund will invest in a representative sample of the shares (equities) of the companies that make up the Index and possibly some securities that are not included in the Index that are designed to help the Fund track the performance of the Index. The Fund's performance is measured against the Index, because the Fund intends to track the performance of the Index. The Index measures the performance of large and medium size companies in developed and emerging markets, as defined by the Index provider.



Main risks

- The value of investments and any income from them can go down as well as up and investors may not get back the amount originally invested
- Where overseas investments are held the rate of currency exchange may cause the value of such investments to go down as well as up.
- The Fund may invest in Emerging Markets, these markets are less established, and often more volatile, than developed markets and involve higher risks, particularly market, liquidity and currency risks.

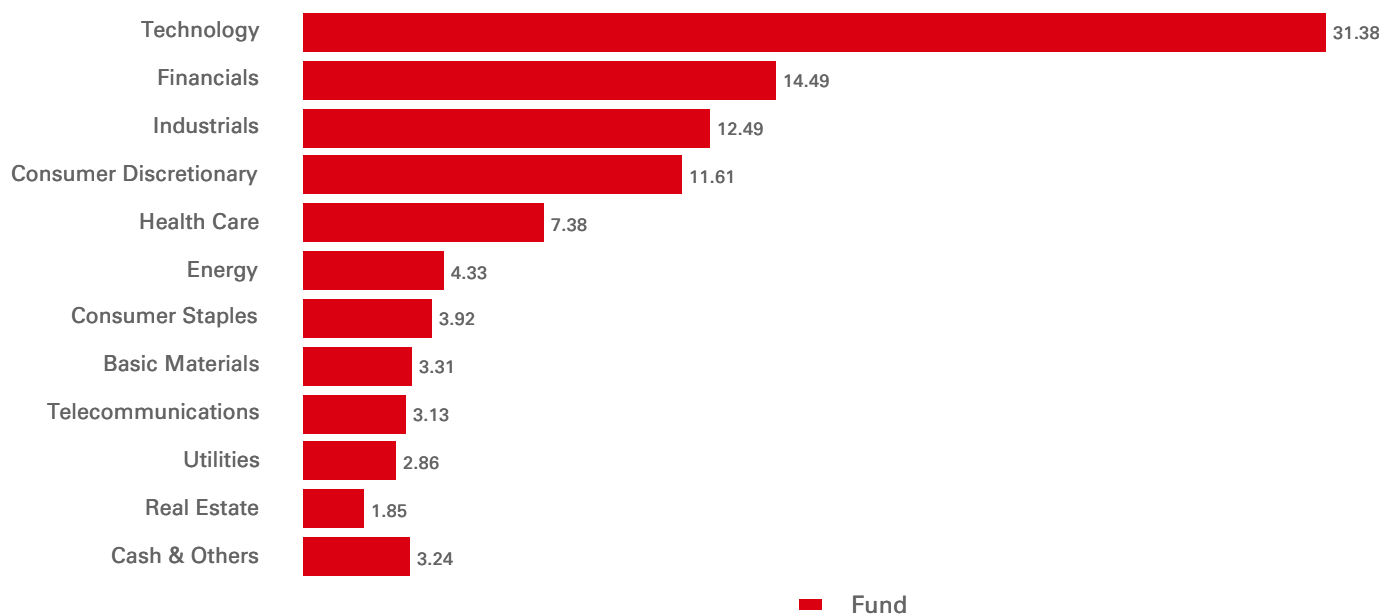

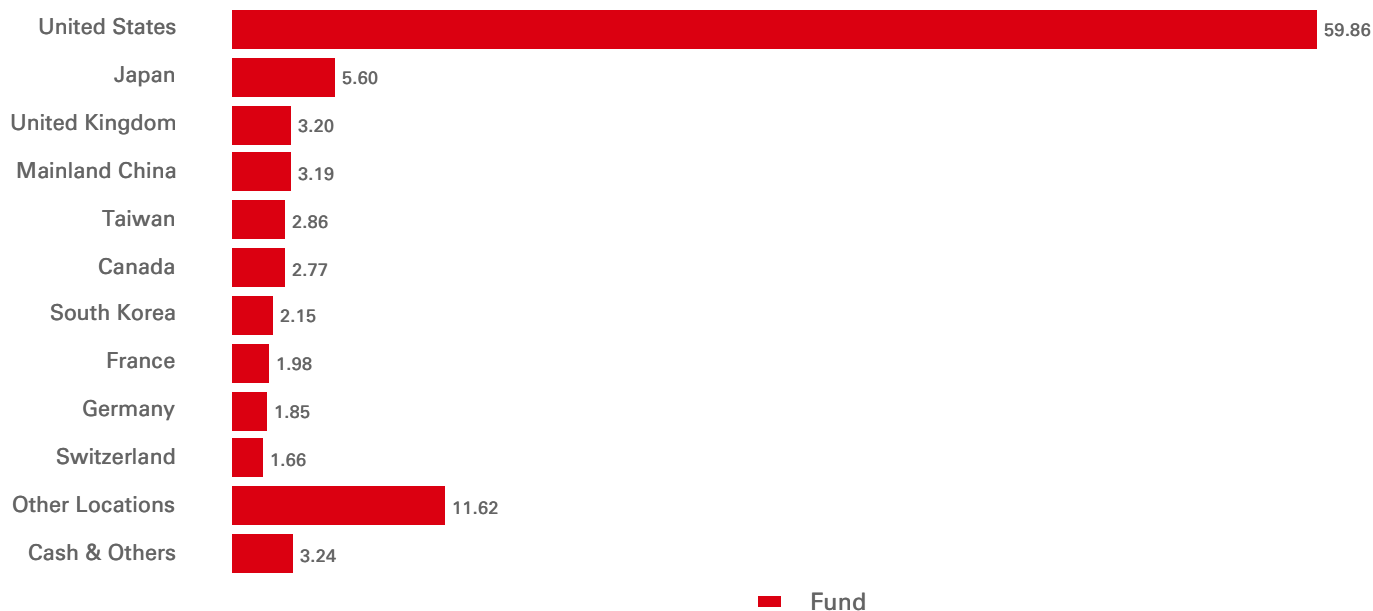
