Investment objective

The Fund aims to track as closely as possible the returns of the MSCI China A Inclusion Index (the Index). The Fund will invest in or gain exposure to shares of companies which make up the Index.



Investment strategy

The Index is made up of China-A shares in the MSCI Emerging Markets Index. It is designed for accessing the China-A shares market via the Shanghai-Hong Kong / Shenzhen-Hong Kong Stock Connect, and is calculated using the offshore China Renminbi exchange rate. The Fund will be passively managed and will aim to invest in the shares of the companies in generally the same proportion as in the Index. However, there may be circumstances when it is not possible or practical for the Fund to invest in all constituents of the Index. If the Fund cannot invest directly in the companies that constitute the Index, it may gain exposure by using other investments such as depositary receipts, derivatives or funds. The Fund may invest in other funds, money market instruments, and up to 10% can be invested in other funds. The Fund may invest up to 35% in securities from a single issuer during exceptional market conditions and up to 10% in total return swaps and contracts for difference. See the Prospectus for a full description of the investment objectives and derivative usage.



Main risks


