### Investment objective

The Fund aims to achieve capital growth over the long term.



### Investment strategy

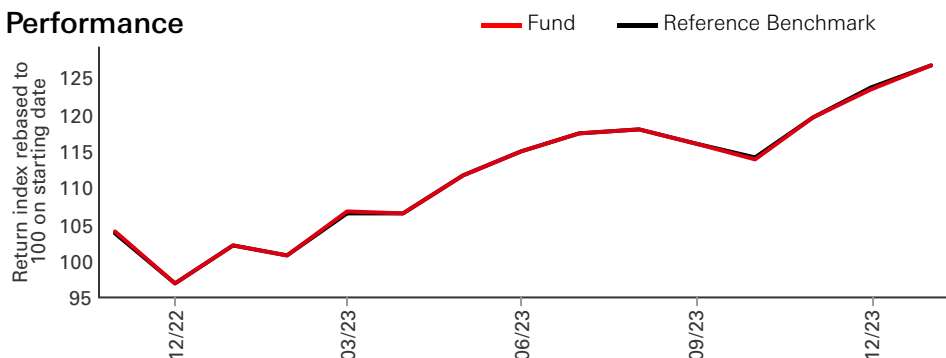
The Fund aims to track as closely as possible the performance of the Dow Jones Islamic Market Titans 100 Index (the Index). The Fund will invest in, or gain exposure to shares of companies which make up the Index. The Index is designed to measure the performance of the largest 100 companies traded globally that pass rule-based screens for adherence to Shariah Principles. The Index Universe comprises all constituent companies of the Dow Jones Islamic Market World Index. The Index excludes shares of companies that generate more than 5% of income or revenue from the business activities such as: alcohol, tobacco, pork-related products, conventional financial services, weapons and defences, certain entertainment. The Fund will be passively managed and will aim to invest in the shares of the companies in generally the same proportion as in the Index. The Fund will only invest in shares of companies that meet Shariah compliance principles as interpreted or approved by the Shariah Committee. The Fund may invest up to 10% of its assets in other funds and may hold cash. The Fund will not invest in funds that are themselves tax transparent vehicles. ### Main risks

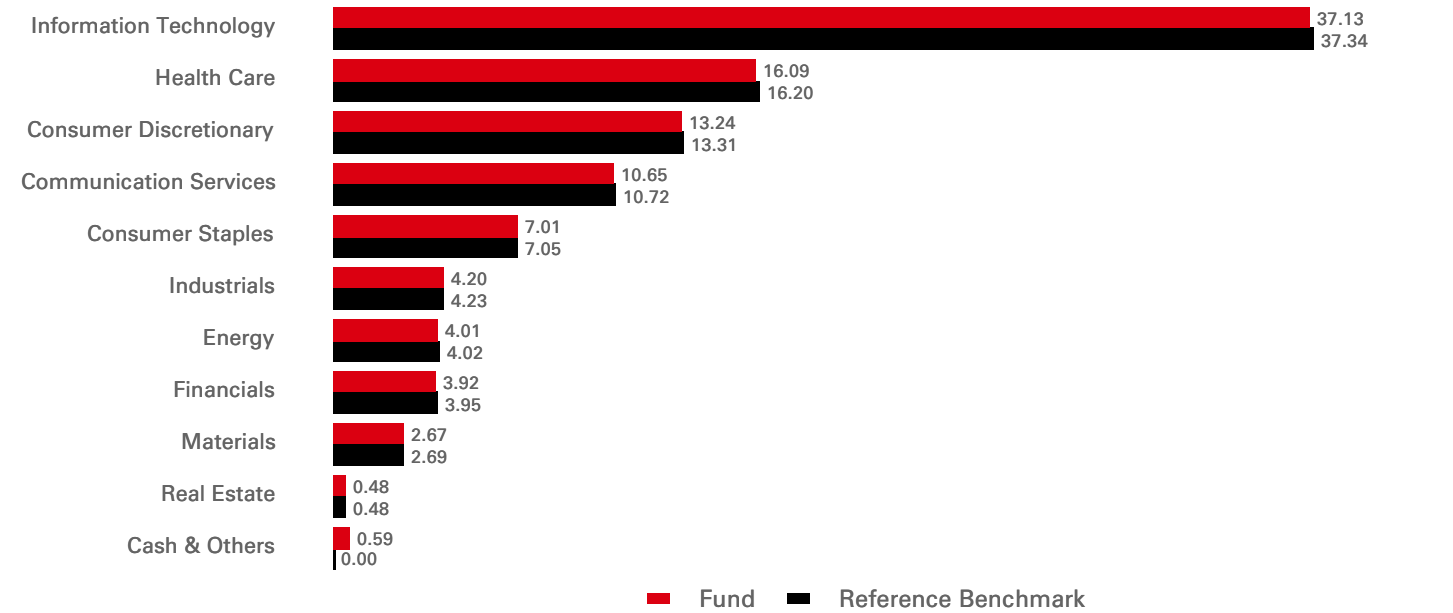

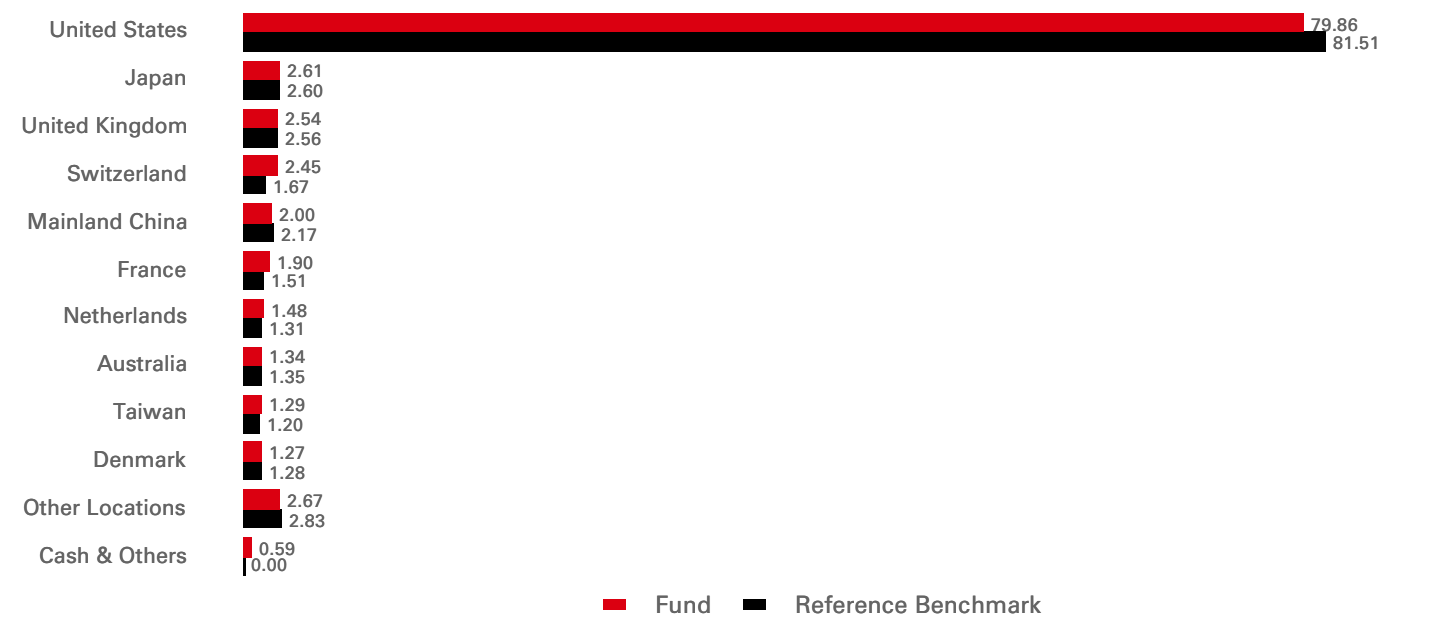
