Dear Unitholder,

The board of directors of the manager, Carne Global Fund Managers (Ireland) Limited (the "Board"), in consultation with HSBC Global Asset Management (UK) Limited (the "Investment Manager"), has carried out a review of the fees of HSBC UCITS Common Contractual Fund - Islamic Global Equity Index Fund (the "Fund"). This notification is to inform you of our proposal to reduce the fees charged to the Fund following the review.

Details of the Fee Reduction

The Fund's fees for the A2CGBP and A3CGBP unit classes will be reduced as shown in the table below:

	Fixed Management Fee	Capped Administration Fee	Published Ongoing Charge
Current	0.18%	0.12%	0.27%
Proposed	0.105%	0.045%	0.15%

The proposed changes will become effective, subject to the approval of the Central Bank, on 1 December 2025 (the "Effective Dates").

Impact on Unitholders

The Board would like to assure Unitholders that the Fund's investment objective and the way it is managed will not change.

Action to be taken

No action is required, however Unitholders may want to update their systems and records as appropriate as at the relevant Effective Date. The latest documents including the prospectus, supplements and Key Investor Information Document (KIID) are available in the Fund Centre at www.assetmanagement.hsbc.com or from HSBC Asset Management office.

Future Changes

The Investment Manager is also reviewing the Fund's Index and is planning a change of index. Further information regarding any proposal to change the Fund's Index will be sent to Unitholders once the Investment Manager's review has been completed.
