Investment objective

The Fund aims to provide long-term capital growth and seeks to invest in instruments that offer thematic equity exposure.



Investment strategy

The Fund is actively managed. The Fund intends to achieve its investment objective by investing in a concentrated (relative to its reference benchmark) portfolio of shares and similar securities of companies worldwide that are enablers or beneficiaries of digital transformations, while promoting environmental, social and governance (ESG) characteristics within the meaning of Article 8 of the European Union's SFDR. The Fund will invest up to 100% of its assets in equity securities linked to the digital transformation, defined as the integration of digital technology into a company, through utilisation of data and analytics, that results in a fundamental change in how the company operates. The Fund may invest up to 10% in cash and other funds for ancillary liquidity purposes. The Fund uses a bottom-up approach focused on investing, in companies that are investing in digitally transforming their businesses. The Investment Manager also applies a sustainability framework to evaluate a company's ESG characteristics, incorporating both quantitative and qualitative analysis based on three key themes: Low Carbon Infrastructure, Data Stewardship and Transitioned Tech Disruptors. Main risks

- The Fund may be concentrated in a limited number of securities, economic sectors and/or countries and as a result, may be more volatile and have a greater risk of loss than more broadly diversified funds.




