# HSBC MSCI EMERGING MARKETS VALUE SCREENED UCITS ETF

## Investment objective

The Fund aims to track as closely as possible the returns of the MSCI Emerging Markets Value Select Screens Advanced Index (the Index), that provides investors the opportunity to gain specific exposure to companies with lower market valuations relative to their fundamental value, while integrating environmental, social and governance (ESG) metrics. The Fund will invest in or gain exposure to shares of companies which make up the Index. The Fund qualifies under Article 8 of SFDR.

## Investment strategy

The Index is a subset of the MSCI Emerging Markets Index (Parent Index), and is made up of large and mid-cap companies based in emerging markets worldwide, as defined by the Index Provider. The Index applies screens to the Parent Index to exclude securities of companies with exposure to: controversial and nuclear weapons, adult entertainment, alcohol, gambling, nuclear power, thermal coal power, fossil fuel and tobacco. The Fund is passively managed and aims to invest in the shares of the companies in generally the same proportion as in the Index.

The Fund may invest up to 10% of its assets in other funds, up to 35% of its assets in securities from a single issuer during exceptional market conditions, and up to 10% in total return swaps and contracts for difference.

## Main risks

- The Fund may invest in Emerging Markets, these markets are less established, and often more volatile, than developed markets and involve higher risks, particularly market, liquidity and currency risks.
- To the extent that the Fund seeks to replicate index performance by holding individual securities, there is no guarantee that its composition or performance will exactly match that of the target index at any given time ("tracking error").
- Derivatives may be used by the Fund, and these can behave unexpectedly. The pricing and volatility of many derivatives may diverge from strictly reflecting the pricing or volatility of their underlying reference(s), instrument or asset.

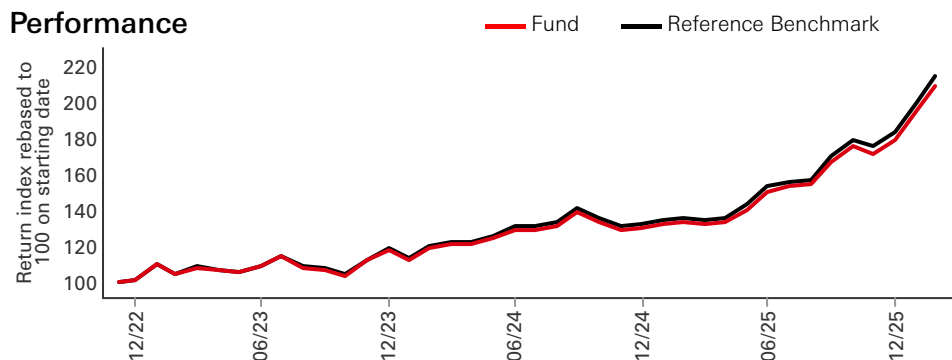

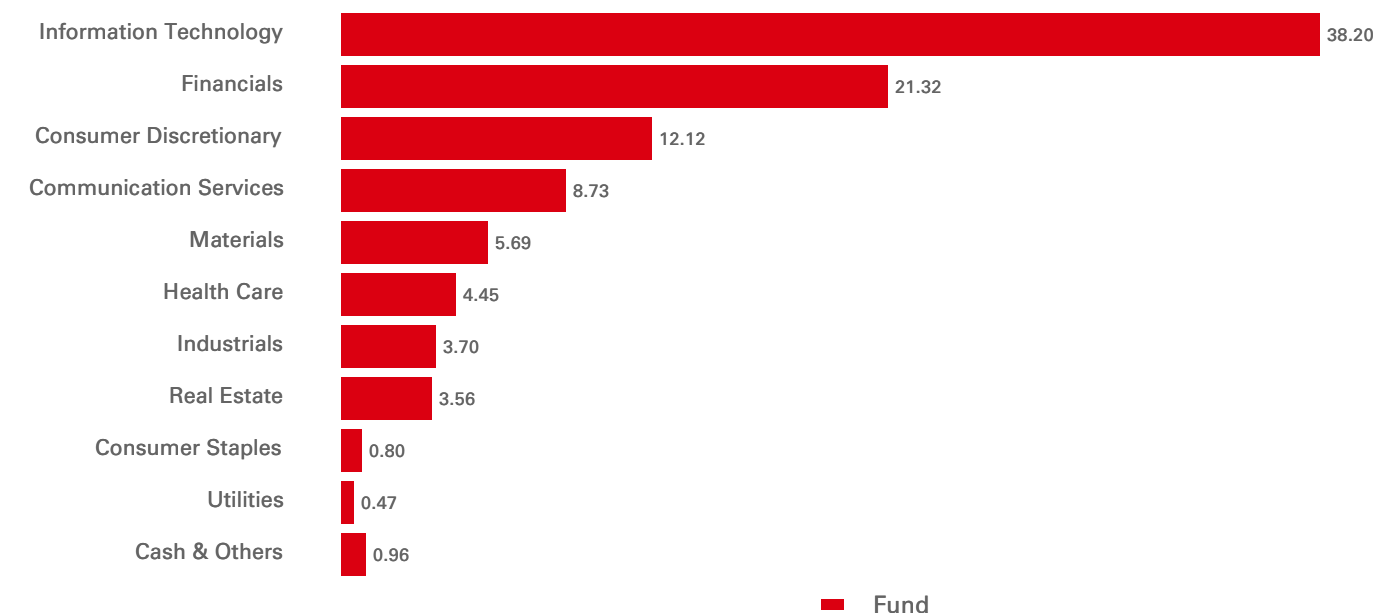

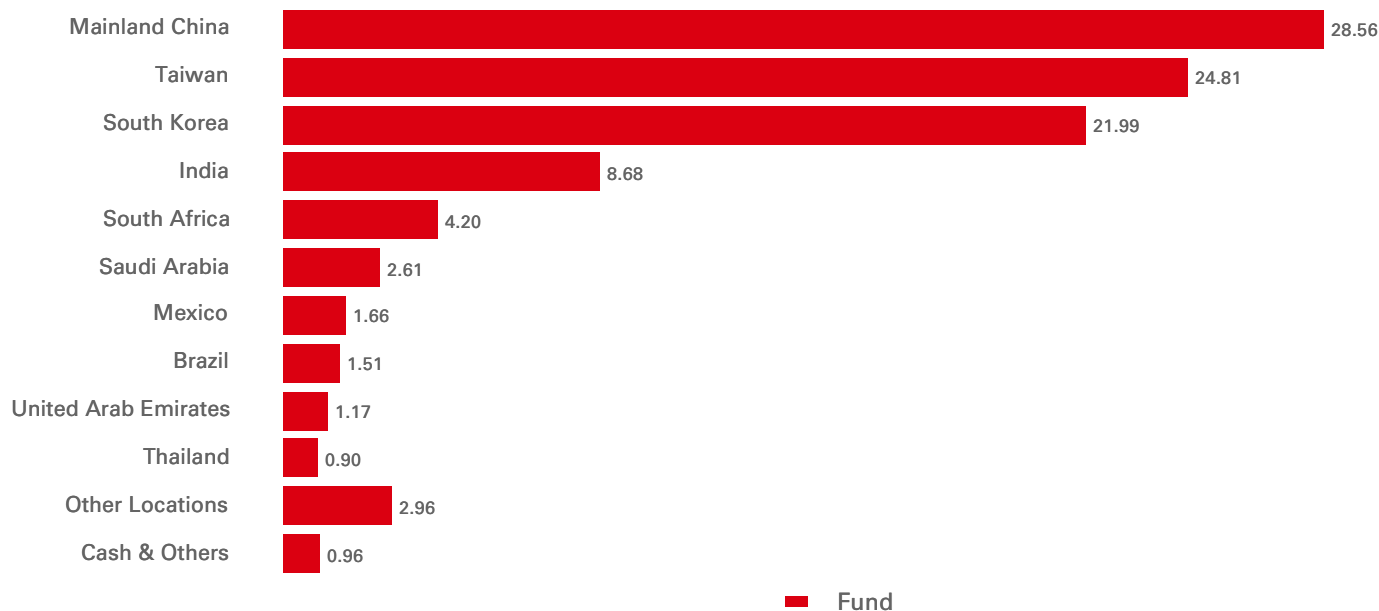
## Sector allocation (%)
