Investment objective

The Fund aims to provide long-term capital growth by tracking as closely as possible the performance of the S&P 500 Net Total Return Index (the Index).



Investment strategy

The Index is comprised of the 500 largest companies in the United States, as defined by the Index provider. The Fund will be passively managed and will aim to invest in the shares of companies in the same proportion as in the Index. However, there may be circumstances when it is not possible or practical for the Fund to invest in all constituents of the Index. If the Fund cannot invest directly in the companies that constitute the Index, it can gain exposure by using other investments such as depositary receipts, derivatives and funds. The Fund may also invest in money market instruments. The Fund may invest up to 10% of its assets in other funds, including HSBC funds. It may also invest up to 10% of its assets in total return swaps. The Fund can invest up to 20% in securities from a single issuer, however in exceptional market conditions the Fund can invest up to 35%. Main risks

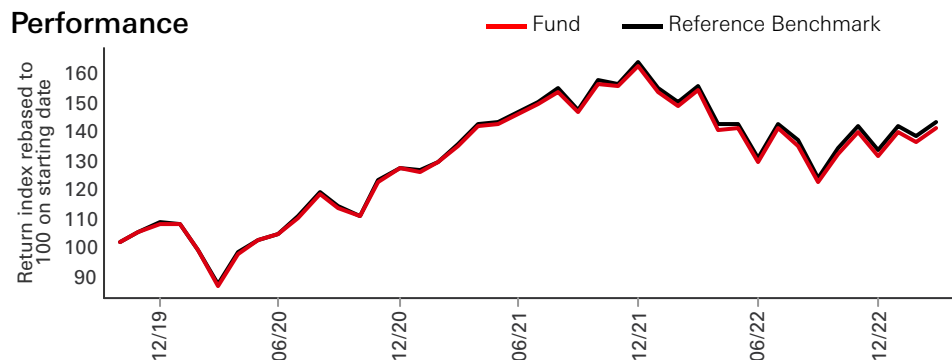

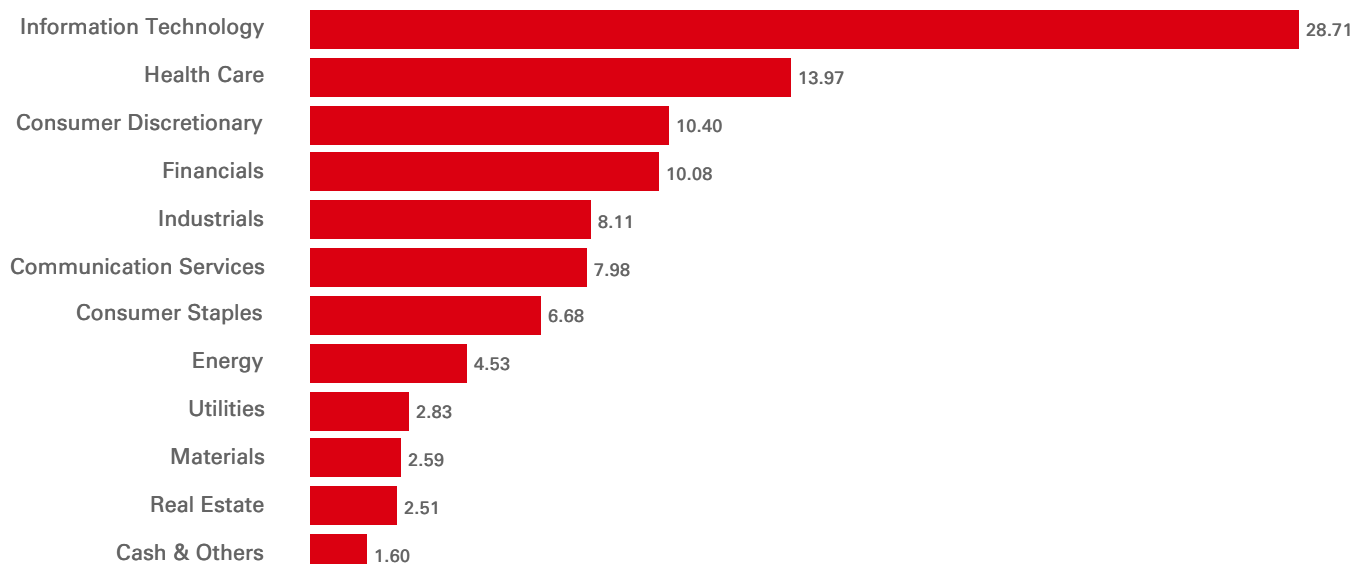
