Investment objective

The Fund aims to provide capital growth and income by investing in a portfolio of emerging market bonds (denominated in local currencies).




Investment strategy

The Fund is actively managed. In normal market conditions, the Fund will primarily invest its assets in investment grade bonds and non-investment grade bonds issued or guaranteed by governments, government-related entities, supranational entities and by companies that are based in emerging markets, as well as currency forwards and non-deliverable forwards. The Fund may invest in securities denominated in US Dollar (USD) or currencies from countries within the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development. The Fund may invest up to 10% in onshore Chinese bonds which are issued within the People's Republic of China and traded on the China Interbank Bond Market. Issuers considered for inclusion within the Fund's portfolio will be subject to excluded activities in accordance with HSBC Asset Management's Responsible Investment Policies, which may change from time to time. The Fund may invest up to 10% in convertible bonds, up to 10% in other funds, may invest in bank deposits and money market instruments for treasury purposes and up to 10% in total return swaps. Main risks

- The value of investments and any income from them can go down as well as up and investors may not get back the amount originally invested
- Investing in assets denominated in a currency other than that of the investor's own currency exposes the value of the investment to exchange rate fluctuations
- The Fund invests in bonds whose value generally falls when interest rates rise. This risk is
 typically greater the longer the maturity of a bond investment and the higher its credit quality.
 The issuers of certain bonds, could become unwilling or unable to make payments on their
 bonds and default. Bonds that are in default may become hard to sell or worthless.


